Chronic Kidney Disease Complications:

- Fluid retention.
- Potassium levels in your blood can suddenly rise (hyperkalemia). It could affect your heart ability to function, which may be life-threatening.
- Cardiovascular disease.
- Increased risk of bone fracture.
- Anemia.
- Decreased sex drive, erectile dysfunction or reduced fertility.
- Your Central nervous system can get damaged, causing difficulty in concentrating, seizures and personality changes.
- Low Immune response.
- Inflammation of the heart membrane.
- Pregnancy complications.
- Permanent kidney damage.
